

ART021 | Chris Akordalitis, Elias Kafouros, Caroline Larsen, Laure Mary

Dio Horia Gallery is pleased to present 'NOW', a selection of works by artists Chris Akordalitis, Elias Kafouros, Caroline Larsen and Laure Mary, to be created especially for ART021 Shanghai 2023. Each artist brings a distinct yet harmonious voice to the collection, creating a captivating tapestry of vibrant landscapes, human form and emotions.

Influenced by his Cypriot roots and inspired by primitive art from Africa, Asia, and French Polynesia, artist Chris Akordalitis has forged a distinctive style. His work combines everyday observations with mystical symbolism, featuring joyful figures in joyful scenes through oil paintings and ceramics. Akordalitis explores the simple pleasures of life as a counterbalance to self-destructive patterns, promoting a utopian escape into nature and dreamlike refuges for tranquility. Capturing the essence of human fragility through his painstaking brushwork, the series of oil paintings presented unravel a love story grounded in the everyday, seamlessly blending Asian and universal themes in a surprising, yet so familiar manner.

Fulbright recipient Elias Kafouros stands out as one of the most significant Greek visual artists in his generation. His work is a reflection of his multifaceted personality, marked by deep perception and philosophical thinking. Kafouros is intrigued by the interplay of flow, narrative, geometry, and symmetry. He creates visually rich compositions by layering objects and figures drawn from everyday life, and shared collective concepts. The bold ink lines and dynamic compositions in his 'Flyer Loops' series involve a mix of diverse elements, all meticulously arranged to achieve visual balance. The core of his work resides in its connection to a virtual space, with a focus on the mental space inside the artwork, unfolding into the intricate layers and arrangements within the artworks.

Following her latest, most successful solo show in Miami, Canadian artist Caroline Larsen showcases her remarkable expertise in the interplay of color and texture. Her acrylic and oil landscapes are a harmonious blend of technical skill and her discerning use of colors and textures, resulting in a deeply engaging and emotional experience for the viewer. What sets her work apart is the tactile quality, as the textured surfaces invite viewers to not only see but touch the art, drawing them into a dreamlike world. In her art, one doesn't merely observe but actively engages with a multisensory experience, forging a profound connection between the art and its audience.

Completing the quartet of presented artists, Laure Mary showcases her last two works signing with her full name, and an extra work that introduces a new period in her artistic practice. Delving into contemplations of the passage of time, this French artist, well-known for her participation in numerous institutional exhibitions, infuses everyday scenes with an eerie and surreal quality. Her artistic technique is meticulous, as she employs labor-intensive methods in her oil paintings, making objects defy gravity, placing animals in domestic settings, and



portraying chairs that seem to fall of their own accord. Remarkably, her art is devoid of human presence, fostering an openness to interpretation and hinting that the central action occurs just beyond the canvas.

The juxtaposition of Akordalitis' delicate touch, Kafouros' expressive ink work, Larsen's vibrant hues and Laure Mary's surrealistic approach creates a visual dialogue that explores the vast spectrum of human experiences. Together, these four artists weave a captivating narrative of the human condition, inviting viewers to reflect on their own vulnerabilities, strengths, and emotions. Their collective presentation serves as a reminder of the infinite possibilities that lie within the realm of contemporary art, capturing the essence of what it means to be human in all its complexities.

- Chris Akordalitis (b.1989, Paphos, Cyprus) lives and works in Paphos. He received an MFA from Kunst academy in Düsseldorf, where he studied painting under Prof. Andreas Schulze and sculpture under the artist Tony Cragg.
